# Shanghai Summer School 2021 Chinese Traditional Music Program of Shanghai Conservatory of Music Admission Brochure

**Shanghai Summer School 2021** – **Chinese Traditional Music Program**, a Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship Program hosted by Shanghai Conservatory of Music (SHCM), will be held online from June to September 2021. It aims to better promote the international education of the SHCM through more diverse Chinese culture experience programs for international students.

### I. Theme

The Shanghai Summer School - Chinese Traditional Music Program has been successfully held for nine consecutive years since 2011, and achieved good results. Building on its previous achievements, the 2021 edition of this event will focus on "Chinese Traditional Musical Instruments (Erhu, Guzheng and Sheng)" and "Chinese Art Song Singing", giving international students a taste of the rich and profound Chinese music culture.

#### II. Time and Activities

- i) Time: June September 2021
- ii) Activities
  - a) Master Class: Through workshops and open classes by prestigious educators and famous performing artists and training courses by young performers of the SHCM, participants will get professional instructions and learn traditional performing techniques, thus achieving rapid progress in their music performance.
  - b) Culture Lecture: Lectures on topics including "The Art of Chinese Music", "The Aesthetics of Music", "Chinese Culture" and "Contemporary China" will be delivered by reputed scholars to introduce the development of contemporary China and different aspects of Chinese music culture.
- iii) This year's program will be delivered entirely online.

### III. Enrollment Quota

The Shanghai Summer School 2021 — Chinese Traditional Music Program is open to international students and scholars between the ages of 16 to 45. Participants must be non-Chinese citizens residing outside China. The program is expected to enroll 20 qualified applicants as Shanghai municipal government scholarship students.

Admission decision will be made by the International Education Department of SHCM after

- i) Application Period: May 1<sup>st</sup>-31<sup>st</sup>, 2021
- ii) How to Apply: Application should be made online via the website: <u>admission.shcmusic.edu.cn</u>.
  Please read the attached *Online Application Instructions* carefully before making an application.
- iii) Documents to be Uploaded for the Online Application:
  - a) A scanned copy of the photo page of the applicant's passport
  - b) An ID photo and a casual life photo
  - c) Studying Certificate or Graduation Certificate
  - d) A Curriculum Vitae (in Chinese or English)
  - e) Video recording of the applicant's music performance (if any): limited to one music piece; max file size: 500MB.
- iv) Fees

The application fee and tuition of the program will be covered by the Shanghai Government Scholarship; other expenses should be borne by the participants themselves.

- v) Application Procedures and Special Notes
  - a) Visit the webpage <u>admission.shcmusic.edu.cn</u> for online application and fill in the form in Chinese or English as required.
  - b) The *Admission Notice* will be sent via email to qualified applicants. Please provide accurate email information in the application form.
  - c) Admitted participants should complete online registration process on the date designated in the *Admission Notice*. Those who can't register on time for due reasons should negotiate with the International Education Division of the SHCM in advance.
  - d) The application materials submitted will not be returned.
